



General

- Stay informed and prepared to follow public health advice.
- Practice good hygiene (wash your hands, avoid touching your face, cough and sneeze into your sleeve or tissue). If you have your own hand sanitizer, please bring with you.
- Maintain a physical distancing of at least two meters or six feet.
- Please adhere to all signage which contains important information.
- Do not approach staff or violate the required physical distancing.
- Do not come to the club if you are sick or feeling unwell.
- No congregating anywhere on site before and after your round.

Proshop

- Proshop will be closed except for washroom access, which will be limited to one individual at a time. If you wish to use the washroom facilities, please knock on pro shop door and a member of staff will let you in when they are available. There will be hand sanitizer located outside the pro shop for you to use. Washrooms will be sanitized regularly. On course washroom will not be open except for use by green staff.
- Proshop will be selling the following items from the pro shop: beer, pop, bars, chips, tees, and balls.
- **No outside alcohol is permitted on the course as per licensing laws. Violators will be asked to leave without refund.**
- Club storage and locker facilities are closed. Please change shoes in parking lot.
- Club rental is allowed.
- Practice putting green is open for golfers to use prior to their tee time and not general practice. There will be no cups in place. Junior driving range is open for use, please inform Pro Shop if using driving range and follow instruction. Always maintain physical distancing.
- Scorecards will be available on request by notifying pro shop staff. We will also have a [printable](#) version for you to download at home if required.

Restaurant/Bar

- Closed for the season on Friday 28th August 2020.

Booking and Payment

- Tee times have been set to 12-minute intervals to ensure appropriate spacing on the course.
- Members can book 7 days in advance. Non-members can book 96 hours in advance.
- Tee-times will start at 7am until 13th September, then first tee time will be 8am. Everyone must start from the 1st tee, however, pro shop staff can use their discretion dependant on how busy the tee sheet is.
- Early morning golfers (prior to 7am) are still permitted. They must inform the proshop **the day before** to determine when they will be playing. This may be modified if abused.



- Groups must consist of 2, 3 or 4 players until 3pm. Prior to 3pm single golfers will be grouped with another group where possible. If it is a quiet day, we will permit single golfers prior to 3pm. This will be at the discretion of the pro shop staff.
- All players must have a tee time. No walk-on players will be permitted.
- Bookings are to be made either online through [Tee-on](#) or by calling 256-4653.
- Payment can be made at the pro shop. Cash will not be accepted.
- Please arrive no earlier than 20 minutes prior to your tee time.

Power and Pull Cart Rental

- Walking is encouraged. Pull carts are available.
- Power carts will be limited to one person per cart unless the occupants are in the same household or bubble.
- Do not allow another individual not in your household/bubble to ride with you at anytime i.e. when travelling to 8th and 13th tee.
- If cart is being used by one individual, only their clubs can be on the cart. Do not transport equipment of others unless they are in your household/bubble.
- Power carts and pull carts will be sanitized after each use.
- Please clean your garbage out of power cart prior to returning to the clubhouse. Any items left in cart will be disposed of.
- Please return power cart promptly after completion of round and follow instruction of staff when parking golf cart.
- Please respect our power carts as if they are your own. Their purpose is to assist you around the golf course in a leisurely manner and nothing else.
- If any of the above power cart stipulations are not adhered to, your cart privileges will be revoked.

Golf Course

- On the first tee please adhere to the 12-minute tee intervals. Do not play just because the group is out of range.
- Please maintain an adequate distance between your group and the group in front.
- If a group is waiting to tee-off, please stay back a safe distance until they have played.
- Avoid slow play. If you are taking too long, please pick up your ball and move on or let the group behind you play through, leaving adequate space between each group. If you must let a group play through, please do so on the fairway and not on the tee or green where it is more difficult to maintain physical distancing.
- Please use tee blocks which best suit your ability. Tee blocks will consist of Gold (forward) and White.
- Remember under the rules of golf you are only allowed three minutes to search for your ball.



- Interior areas of the course (outer edge of rough - not fairway side) are now classed as penalty areas and relief should be taken as per the [Rules of Golf](#). The boundaries of the course are still out of bounds. Only hit a provisional ball if you believe your ball is out of bounds.
- Please do not use benches, touch tee blocks, pick up equipment, broken tees or golf balls that are not yours.
- Ball and club washers have been removed. Rakes have been removed from bunkers. Please smooth over sand after use. Preferred lies can be taken in bunker, place ball one club-length not nearer to the hole than where the ball came to rest. Ball must remain in the bunker.
- Do not touch flag or flagpole. There will be a foam noodle inserted into cups to make retrieving ball easier. Please only use two fingers.
- Course is not to be used for practice.
- Do not shake hands after round or exchange any cash.
- Please leave the premises on completion of your round.

Other

- Juniors **under 14** must be accompanied by an adult.
